Queenstown Adventurous, Breathtaking, Majestic

DAY 1 Arrive into Auckland and transfer on to Queenstown – “The Adventure Capital of the World.” Board a waiting *jet boat* at a jetty next to Queenstown Airport for an unforgettable arrival into the area. *Wine tasting* and lunch is enjoyed at a *local vineyard* surrounded by *picturesque scenery*. A stop is made at the famous *Kawarau Bungy Bridge*, giving guests the opportunity to watch this adventure sport, and perhaps be inspired to return and try it themselves. Dinner will be held on site at the hotel this evening, and a *Maori performing group* will welcome and entertain the group prior to being seated for dinner.

DAY 2 Travel from Queenstown to *Glenorchy* – a quaint township situated at the head of *Lake Wakatipu*. Here, guests will join the *Dart River Safari* for a scenic trip into the foothills of *Mount Aspiring National Park*. This trip is conducted by *coach* and *jet boat*. The jet boat offers a way to see parts of the spectacular National Park otherwise only accessible by foot. Following the excursion, lunch will be served in Glenorchy. This evening a local dine-around will take place - allowing guests to sample one of the many *award-winning restaurants* Queenstown has to offer.

DAY 3 Today is at leisure and free for individual pursuits. There is no shortage of activities in Queenstown! Guests may like to *bungee jump, parapente, fish for trout, go horseback or quad bike riding, white water rafting*, play a round of *golf*, blast up the Shotover River on a *Shotover Jet boat*, fly to the '8th Wonder of the World' – *Milford Sound*, take the *historic TSS Earnslaw steamship* to Walter Peak Station & Homestead for morning tea and a farm show, relax with a *massage or facial*, or take in the *Queenstown shops*.

DAY 4 Today, *4WD vehicles* take guests along the rugged and isolated *Skippers Canyon road* – one of the most significant gold mining access routes left in New Zealand today, and considered to be Queenstown's most spectacular back country trip. The vehicles cross the Skippers Canyon Swing Bridge and stop for guests to enjoy a brew of tea and an opportunity to try their hand at *gold panning*. The historic and restored Skippers Canyon township is visited before taking the winding trail road back to Queenstown. This evening the group dines exclusively in a charming, historic and *iconic Queenstown restaurant*.

DAY 5 Today is at leisure and free for individual pursuits. Guests choose their final Queenstown activity to conclude their New Zealand experience. Tonight's farewell function will be held at the *Skyline complex* (accessed

by *gondola*) sitting high above the lake and town, and overlooking the magnificent *Remarkables mountain range*. Watch the setting sun cast its shadow on the mountains and enjoy fabulous food, wine and entertainment - in true 'Kiwi' style.

DAY 6 Transfer to Queenstown Airport for the departure flight from New Zealand. Alternatively, create a program which combines Queenstown with Auckland.
